We continue working on recognize the letter of the month, "S'" and "B" and spelling and writing their names.



In the month of August, we will be working on the Five Senses: sight, smell, hearing, taste, and touch. We will discuss examples of SIGHT (colors, faces, eyes), SMELL (flowers, scented markers, Kool-Aid), HEARING (car sounds, animal sounds, musical instruments), TASTE (sour, salty, warm, cold), and TOUCH (soft, rough, gushy, bumpy). We will also make some fun crafts related to the theme and continue working on recognizing tracing and writing the letters of the Alphabet.
