KOALAS (5 Year Olds)



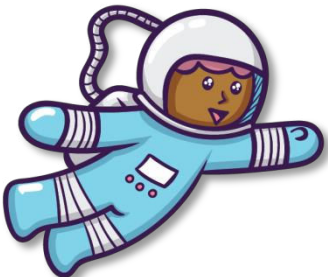
