 Parents are responsible for this check in and must have Unique badge ready every Morning. (An email is sent every morning at 5 am to be completed prior to drop off. If your child is not Validated (With a Green Badge), your child will not be accepted for the day!)
- Students Must be Wearing Their Mask during drop off time, it is not teacher's responsibility to put students mask on during drop off.
- Students will not be carried in the classroom, allow your child enough time to wake up and walk to the door so that the teachers don't carry students in.

CHIPMUNKS (3 Year Olds)


Hello December!
