PLEASE NO OPEN TOE SHOES!

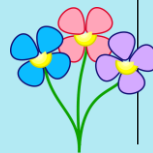
If possible, please label your children's belongings.

At Toddler Town Daycare, outside/home food and outside/home toys are not allowed or permitted at our center. Please keep home toys at home or in your vehicle, and, if you want your child to eat food outside our center, please have your child finish it in the car, but do not take it further in the school, or it will be tossed out. Also, cups allowed in the center are only cups that have water or that are empty, if you bring a cup or bottle containing anything else, we will send it back home. Please refer to your Toddler Town Parent policy handbook regarding these rules.

Last month our Preschoolers graduated from Toddler Town, that means it's officially summer at Toddler Town. During the summer, we love to engage our students in all physical activities possible. Summer is here for such a short amount of time that we need to take advantage of every bit of it. Every Friday after graduation we plan for something special, a small little celebration for summer, teachers will keep you posted on the ProCare Engagement App.

Last month students enjoyed learning about colors, worms and water! We will begin this month with our monthly festivities, the 4th of July! Children will engage in learning safety protocols around fireworks and making fun arts and crafts honoring our country. This month we will engage in our All About Butterfly unit. Throughout our All About butterflies, we will learn concepts and skills in language and literacy, math, science, social studies, the arts, and technology. We will also be using thinking skills to investigate, ask questions, solve problems, make predictions, and test our ideas.

We also want to remind parents that we will be going to the neighborhood park as much as we can. Please talk to your child about street safety, looking both way when crossing the streets, following directions, and talking to strangers. We are asking parents to please donate cases of small water bottles. Everyone is great at bringing their own water bottles, but we want to make sure no one is left without water when the water bottle is forgotten. Please bring sun lotion or sun spray, one per child, we will be using it often. Also, we have noticed parents not taking blankets home on Fridays. Please take them home to wash. If you do forget the blanket, bring a clean one on Monday and we will swap it out.

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Butterflies (3-5 Year Old's)
