REMEMBERS!





Welcome to the month of June! We are halfway in the year, and we had learned so much! Last month was so exciting with our PETS unit. We had fun learning about the different types of pets and how we can nurture them and include them in our families. We learned the difference between Pet Animals and Wild Animals. We discovered the animals that belong in water, land, and air. We did some cool arts and crafts and enjoyed our dramatic play Pet Store!

I am super excited to transition to our new topic- Plants! Perfect topic for Summer! Students will explore all about Plants! What are plants? Why do we need plants? We will learn about the Life Cycle of a Plant and the plants structure (body parts). Students will be hands on planting their seeds, and as a class we will observe and record our plant discoveries daily. Students will also nurture and care for our "Botany Experimental Green House" (I will later send a picture of how this experimental kit looks like) Of course we will have theme related vocabulary words and our weekly focus each week- Number, Letter, Shape, and Color.
