**Make sure credit cards are up to date and to make payments on 1<sup>st</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> of every month**

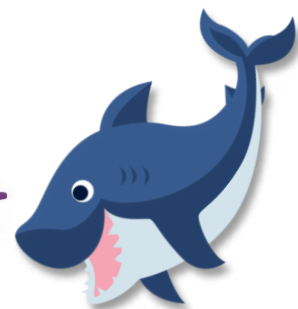

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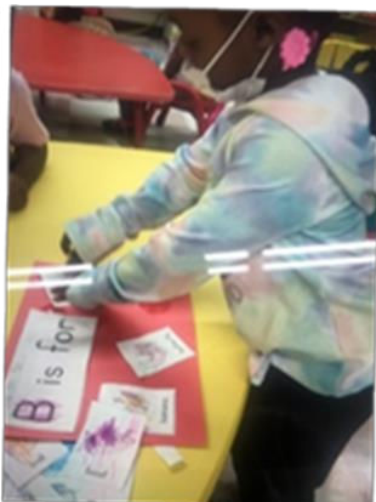
## CHIPMUNKS (3 Year Olds)

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## BUMBLEBEES (2 Year Olds)

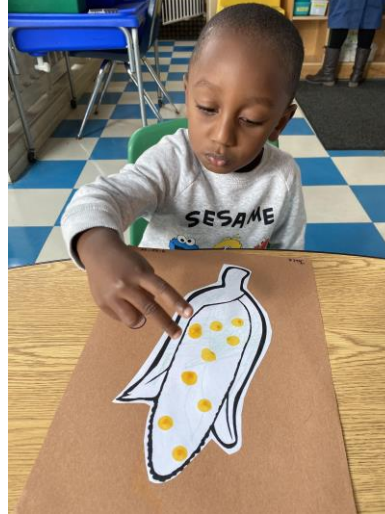
Hello Parents and Hello OCTOBER!
