
Toddler Town January 2021 Newsletter



Toddler Town Continues to follow all CDC guidelines for Covid-19. We want to remind our families about a few things:

- Due to Covid, our Hours are from 7am- 5pm. Late arrivals will be charged a late fee of \$15 every ten minutes.
- 2. Parents must park legally in order to drop-off and pick-up students.
- 3. All Parent and students must be wearing masks during drop-off and pick-up.
- 4. Parents must complete CrisisGo questionnaire 30 mins prior to drop-off, teachers verify temperatures during drop off and record the temperatures.
- We are now Using ProCare Connect to communicate back and forth with families, implement observations and for reports.

- 2. Download the app and log-in after signing up through the sent link.
- 6. Tuition payments must be made at the beginning of the month. If full tuition isn't paid, a minimum of half tuition must be made on the first, and the remaining balance must be paid by the 15th of each month.



- · Practicing social distancing between peers.



Bumblebees January 2021!


Hello parents!




