THE EXPLORERS: 4 YEAR OLDS

In July, the Explorers learned about Independence Day; activities involved the flag, fireworks, and the children singing the *50 states* song. During our bug theme, the Explorers learned about the butterfly life cycle and various bugs. During our beach theme, the Explorers learned about activities to do on the beach like swimming. They also pretended to be on the beach in the classroom. Furthermore, they practiced their names, spelling,

and writing. For August, the Explorers will continue learning about the Beach since they enjoyed the topic so much. For math skills,



the class will learn about adding numbers and the concept of greater than, less than and/or equal to. The Explorers will also continue to work on writing their letters in their notebooks. Finally, please remember that Parent/Teacher Conferences will be held to go over your child's progress. Conferences will be the first two weeks in August.

BUMBLEBEES: 4 YEAR OLDS

In the month of July, the students focused on Independence Day, the circus and Ocean Animals. We enjoyed making fireworks with the colors RED, WHITE AND BLUE, since those colors represent the American Flag. We also had fun JUMPING into the Ocean and finding all the animals that live in the ocean. We also made a few animals that we voted on as our favorite. Beach day was all about the shape CIRCLE and SPHERE since a beach ball is round. Also the students were able to lay out and get some sun on their beach towels that they brought in. We enjoyed a lot of fun summer themes.

In the month of August, we will be working on the Five Senses: sight, smell, hearing, taste, and touch. We will discuss examples of SIGHT (colors, faces, eyes), SMELL (flowers, scented markers, Kool-Aid), HEARING (car sounds, animal sounds, musical instruments), TASTE (sour, salty, warm, cold), and TOUCH (soft, rough,

gushy, bumpy). In addition, we also will be going over safety tips while driving in a car. Thought this would be a fun theme to work on since my students are in love with cars, trucks, motorcycles, trains, and airplanes.



BUTTERFLIES: 3 YEAR OLDS

The month of July was so much fun as we learned about the history behind the 4th of July and aquatic animals: octopuses, sharks, stingrays, crabs, and dolphins. We even worked on creative art projects

pertaining to these subjects. We even marched around the neighborhood with our 4th of July hats that the children made. As for our names, we worked on identifying both the letter and sound of the 1st letter in our names. This has been



such a success that the children are even beginning to identify projects based off the names.

August will be just as fun as we will learn about zoo animals in combination with color recognition. We will also work on fun projects related to these animals. We will also be having Parent/Teacher Conferences in August so look for the sign-up sheet to set up a meeting.

Parents please keep track of your child's cubbies and be sure to supply them with enough weather appropriate attire.

TOUCANS: 2 YEAR OLDS

July was a month full of camping experiences. We continued with our insects and spiders study. The children were able to create crafts about different insects while learning more about colors and shapes. Then, we learned more about campfires and bears in the camping grounds. We learned more about what tents are and what they are used for. We explored worms and what they eat. The children were able to see them move around. Aside from all these activities, we learned more about the Fourth of July. We marched outside while waving our flags.

As August approaches, we would like to introduce children to sea life. We will do activities that involve water and crafts. Also since August is the hottest month, we would like to introduce a beach like theme. We are hoping to have a beach party during the month and most of all have fun!
