SHARKS: 5 YEAR OLDS:

Hola! Hope you all are enjoying summer so far. It was really fun to go camping in the classroom and outside in our playground and talking about Kindergarten last month. We have learned about safety, each child made their own safety sign and learned the facts of Independence Day. We also talked about using manners every day.

In August we are looking forward to learning about Ocean animals, Hand washing, Zoo animals and Feelings. For math we will practice counting by 10s and 5s; review all the 2D and 3D shapes we have learned before. We will continue improving our early reading skills with guessing games, clue games, rhyming words, Opposites, sounding out the letters, reading books etc. Children will continue practicing to write their names. A variety of art projects, games, graph and outdoor activities will accompany our learning.

We usually avoid outdoor activities in extreme weather conditions (hot/cold/rain/snow/storm/thunder), which we compensate with indoor exercises/dance/yoga.

Hello August! Throughout the month of July, the Butterflies focused on animals and their habitats. We did our lessons on animals that live in the desert and animals that lived in the rainforest. Students learned about dry lands and wet lands.



In the month of August, the Butterflies will be doing a Ball Study. They will be learning about different kinds of balls, how people use balls, what they are made of, what is inside them and how high they can bounce. If you can, you can send different types of balls to school with your children for our study. As we study balls, we will learn concepts and skills in literacy, math, science, social studies, arts and technology.

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Toddler Town's New Phone System



Ring, Ring! Hello, this is Toddler Town and we would like to inform you of our new phone system. If you have called us, you have probably noticed our new call menu. For those of you who haven't noticed, here is some information to familiarize yourself for the next time you call us.

One of our best features is being able to contact your child's teacher directly, rather than having to be transferred. Each classroom now has a specific extension where you are able to speak and/or leave your child's teacher a message. We ask that when you do leave a message that you please state **Your Name**, **Your Child's Name**, and a Call Back Number. A good idea is to recite the call back number slowly and twice for accuracy. Unfortunately, messages left without call back numbers will not be returned. Also, please give our staff enough time to return your phone call, especially if the call is during class hours when the teachers are attending to the children. Depending on when you call, we will do our best to return your calls during lunch time or within 24 hours. If it is an emergency, do not hesitate to call again or speak to the director directly.
